“BAC RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER EMERGENCY CASES 53.2 - GPPB CIRCULAR 03-2020 DATED 9 MARCH 2020 RE APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF EFFICIENT, EFFECTIVE AND EXPEDIENT PROCUREMENT PROCEDURES DURING A STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY AS AN ALTERNATIVE MODE OF PROCUREMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF INFECTIOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES AT THE MEGA TEMPORARY TREATMENT AND MONITORING FACILITY AT THE PHILIPPINE ARENA, CIUDAD DE VICTORIA, BOCAUE, BULACAN”

WHEREAS, the Office of Civil Defense RO III, through the Bids and Awards Committee requests for the procurement project, " **PROVISION OF INFECTIOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES AT THE MEGA TEMPORARY TREATMENT AND MONITORING FACILITY AT THE PHILIPPINE ARENA, CIUDAD DE VICTORIA, BOCAUE BULACAN**" with a Total Budget of Php **1,049,130.47**. Said project was duly approved by the HOPE with a document/certification from the Finance Section or equivalent position showing that there is a budget for the purpose;

WHEREAS, on **31 December 2019**, a clustering of pneumonia cases of unknown etiology was reported in Wuhan, China. The outbreak was later determined to be caused by a 2019-nCoV, a new corona virus strain that has not been previously identified in humans. Initially, the said disease was thought to be transmitted through animal contact but reports show human-to-human transmission of 2019-nCoV;

WHEREAS, on **31 January 2020**, WHO declared the novel corona virus acute respiratory disease (2019-nCoV ARD) health event as a public health emergency of international concern after an emergency committee convened on 30 January, in Geneva, Switzerland;

WHEREAS, on **7 March 2020**, the DOH raised "Code Red Sub-level 1" alert on the COVID-19. On **12 March 2020**, His Excellency, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte, announced the decision of raising code alert system for COVID-19 in the country to "**Code Red Sublevel 2**;

WHEREAS, the President of the Philippines in the Proclamation No. 929 effective 16 March 2020 declared a State of Calamity throughout the country due to Corona Virus Disease 2019 for a period of six months unless earlier lifted;

WHEREAS, on **16 March 2020**, the Office of the President by virtue of a Memorandum from the Executive Secretary declared the entire Luzon under Enhanced Community Quarantine effective 00:00 A.M 17 March 2020 until 00:00 A.M 13 April 2020. Further, Presidential Proclamation No. 929 was issued on the same declaring a State of Calamity throughout the Philippine due to COVID-19;



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WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 112 dated April 30, 2020 imposed an Enhanced Community Quarantine in High Risk Geographic Areas of the Philippines and a General Community Quarantine in the rest of the country from 01 to 15 May, 2020. Region III (Central Luzon) except Aurora based on data analysis by the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases was included in High Risk Geographic Areas;

WHEREAS, as of 1 September 2020, the region has a total number of 2,284 Suspected COVID-19 Cases, 230 Probable Cases, 5812 Confirmed Cases and 157 Deaths;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above, the Department of Health (DOH) issued a Department Memorandum No. 2020 -0160 with the Subject: Interim Guidelines on Management for the National Capital Region Mega Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities (MTTMF) in the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), World Trade Center (WTC), Rizal Memorial Coliseum (RMC), Ninoy Aquino Stadium, and Philippine. Said guidelines outlines the management of the MTTMFs to include the Philippine Arena;

WHEREAS, pursuant to OCD Memorandum No. 243C s. 2020 dated 01 May 2020, OCD Regional Office 3 was tasked to provide for the logistical requirement of the Philippine Arena TTMF to include Infectious Waste Management Services;

WHEREAS, OCD Regional Office 3 in view of the mentioned tasked, was downloaded funds for the purpose;

WHEREAS, to ensure unhampered operations of the Philippine Arena, in view of the rising need for TTMF which shelters COVID-19 positive patients, the BAC deliberated for the mode of procurement to be adopted;

WHEREAS, upon review of the project requirements the terms and conditions, as specified in GPPB Circular 03-2020 dated 9 March 2020 re approving the adoption of efficient, effective and expedient procurement procedures during a state of Public Health Emergency vis-a-vis conditions present as follows:

- a. *In case of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity.* This procurement is being undertaken to ensure continuous operation at the Philippine Arena TTMF which caters to COVID-19 Positive Patients, the very reason why the President on 16 March 2020 declared State of Calamity throughout the country.
- b. *Provision of immediate response and initial recovery steps to avoid loss of life, injury or disease and other negative effects on human, physical, mental and social well being.* It is imperative to ensure continuous provision of Infectious Waste Management Services to the Philippine Arena TTMF to maintain cleanliness of the facility and to avoid the spread of disease.

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WHEREAS, GPPB Circular NPM No. 005-2020 dated 8 July 2020 re Procurement of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) - Related Projects After the Expiration of Republic Act No. 11469 or the Bayanihan to Heal as One Act states that the lapse of the effectivity of the Bayanihan Act does not preclude PEs from expeditiously procuring the needed Goods, Infrastructure and Consulting Services given that other modes of procurement and efficient measures for the conduct of thereof have been put in place pursuant to RA No. 9184, its IRR and related issuances, and as further enhanced by the recent GPPB issuances such as GPPB Resolution No. 03-2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, We, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby RESOLVE as it hereby resolved:

- a. To recommend Negotiated Procurement Under Emergency Cases 53.2 - GPPB Circular 03-2020 dated 9 March 2020 re Approving the Adoption of Efficient, Effective and Expedient Procurement Procedures during a State of Public Health Emergency as an Alternative Mode of Procurement for the **PROVISION OF INFECTIOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES AT THE MEGA TEMPORARY TREATMENT AND MONITORING FACILITY AT THE PHILIPPINE ARENA, CIUDAD DE VICTORIA, BOCAUE, BULACAN.**
- b. To recommend for the approval by the Head of Procuring Entity (HoPE).
